First, let me thank those of you that have contributed to the Workers Memorial Commons building fund.

West Alabama has an opportunity that few, if any, communities in the world have. The opportunity to build a memorial using part of the *World Trade Center*.

As we struggled with the attack on the *World Trade Center* and with the death of **Antonio Garcia-Reyes** at Stillman College in Tuscaloosa still fresh on our minds, we acquired a portion of *World Trade Center, Tower One* for a Workers Memorial to honor all workers. The memorial is designed for everyone, not just members of organized labor and every April 28th there will be a ceremony remembering those that have been killed or injured on the job.

We have established a public charity, Workers Memorial Commons Foundation, Inc., to manage construction of the memorial. We have also established a web site devoted to Workers Memorial Commons. We are asking our brothers and sisters to help any way they can, whether by contributing or publicizing the need for a workers memorial throughout their community. We are in the process of making presentations to various organizations, corporations and groups of all types, hoping to increase support for Workers Memorial Commons. We welcome the opportunity to share the vision of a memorial in Alabama for all workers killed or injured on the job including the 2749 people that were working and perished on September 11, 2001.

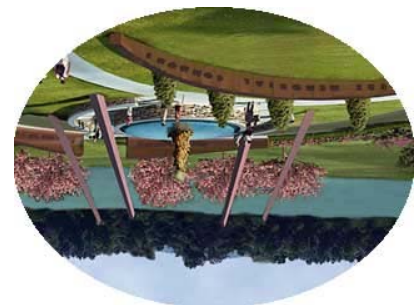
